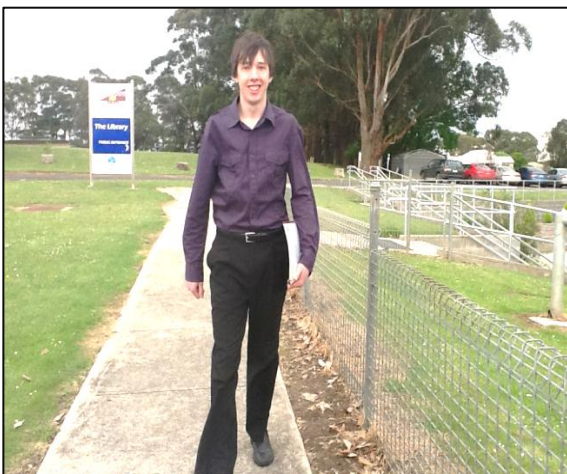

This week we have waved off our eager Grade 4 on their camp to Melbourne. This camp provides our rural students with a wonderful insight into Victoria's capital city and is only possible because of the wonderful staff and volunteers who are prepared to support these types of experiences. Day one went well according to the phone call last night and all are excited to take on day 2 activities.

Our School Council have reviewed several of our current policies and recommended changes to them. In particular our Uniform Policy has been reviewed and several changes have now been adopted as our new Policy. To support families with the changes compliance time lines have been established. The new policy will begin for term one 2013 with other changes uptake set for the start of 2014. In the lead up to this new Policy all staff have been asked to look at current practice and support students being in correct uniform. This week we have followed this up with checks and conversations about the kinds of changes that some students will require. On the first day of this focus we had 9% of our P-6 students not in full school uniform. Whereas, on the second check we had halved this number with just 4.5% of students being out of uniform. We will again be conducting this

check tomorrow and it is hoped that we have a further reduction with our aim being for 100% compliance. If you know your child is out of uniform please support our School Policy and make adjustment.

- Unwanted old tools and equipment (saws, rakes, hoes, wagon wheels, etc)

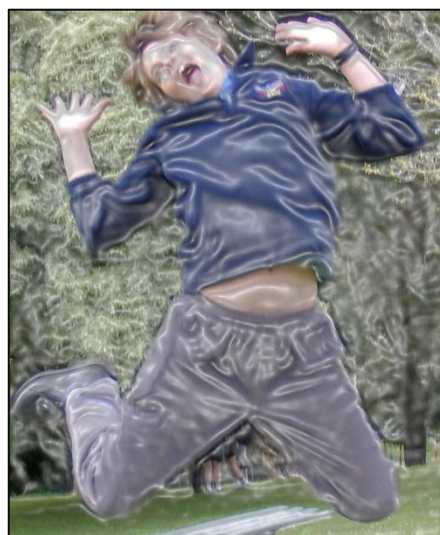

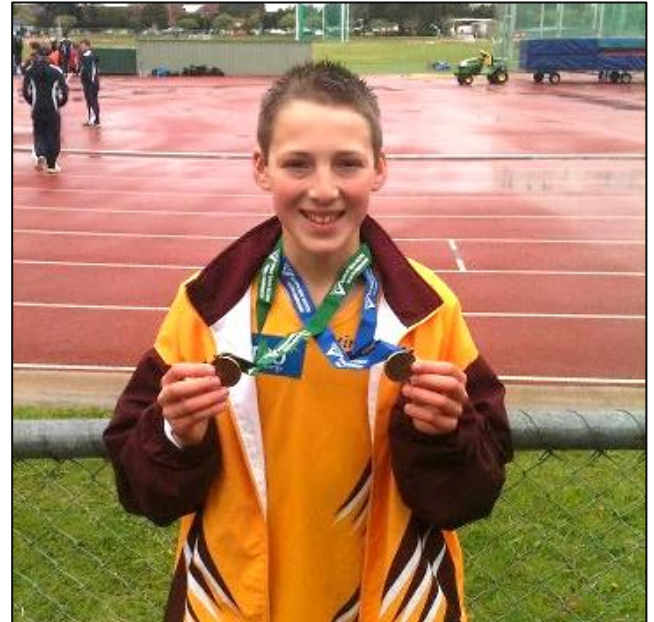

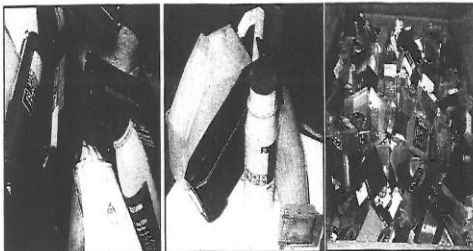
