# **2016 Scholarships**

Timboon P12 School invites families to apply for the following scholarships.

## **Year 7**

The scholarship is open to students currently in Year 6 at Timboon P12 School and to prospective students who will enter Timboon P12 at Year 7 in 2016.

## **Year 12**

The scholarship is open to all current Year 12 students currently enrolled at Timboon P12 School in 2015.

### **Application Process**

All current and prospective students for the Year 7 scholarship must sit a scholarship examination. This examination will be held on Sunday 15<sup>th</sup> November 2015.

Candidates should arrive before 10:00am and will be available for collection at the conclusion of the test at approximately 11:00am

A letter confirming details of the test will be received shortly after completing the registration form.

# Selection of Scholarship

Selection of Scholarship Recipients will be managed by a panel appointed by the Timboon P12 School and the Timboon Lions Club.

Applications will be individually assessed with applications treated in the strictest confidence.

The panel will consider the following in selecting scholarship recipients:

- Demonstrated commitment to achieving their best academically.
- Demonstrated leadership in their local community, for example, participating in community organisations, events, sporting clubs etc., volunteering and/or mentoring experience, sharing family roles and responsibilities, extracurricular roles at school.
- Managing or overcoming personal difficulties, i.e financial disadvantage, remoteness, loss of family member, cultural issues.

The School Principal must endorse the application by initialling each page of the application. In doing so he/she is stating that to the best of his/her knowledge the information provided is true and correct.

The Timboon Lions Club will offer three scholarships annually:

- Year 12 to Tertiary- \$1,000 on a one off basis
- VCAL to workforce/trade- \$800 on a one off basis
- Year 6 to Year 7- \$500 on a one off basis

The money for the Year 12 scholarship will be made available when the student provides proof of acceptance into a recognised Tertiary Institution. The scholarship cannot be deferred.

The money for the VCAL student is payable when that student provides proof of employment in his/her chosen industry/trade.

The money for the Year 6 student to Year 7 student will be paid to the school.

## **Criteria Year 7 Scholarship:**

- An examination (50 minute writing task)- weighting 30%
- An interview- weighting 50%
- Assessed on community involvement- weighting 20%

## **Criteria Year 12 Scholarship:**

- A 50 minute writing task)- weighting 30%
- An interview- weighting 50%
- Assessed on community involvement- weighting 20%

\*Year 12 VCE student: Achieved a minimum ATAR score 70.

Provide at least written 1 reference (Teacher, Employer, Coach).

**All scholarships will be awarded at the Timboon P12 Awards Ceremony on Wednesday 16<sup>th</sup> December, 2015.**
